#### Classroom Activities

#### First Grade



The first grade students enjoyed exploring many Christmas children's books during the past month. We have a read-aloud story time each day, and it has become a favorite time for the students and the teacher! This is also the time in which we discuss the book and work on comprehension skills. We use the story time to develop and practice writing sentences. In math, the first graders have been focusing on subtraction and fact families.

#### **Second Grade**

In math, they are playing the game "Go Fish". Currently, they are fishing for combinations for two numbers that add up to 13.
