Language Arts

In language arts we are still on our Mystery Unit! Your child should be bringing home a book club mystery book a few days a week. Math: Our class is continuing with a mathematics unit about decimals called Decimals on Grids and Number Lines. During this unit, students investigate the meaning of decimals. They develop an understanding of the relationships among fractions, percents, and decimals, by building on the work from our pervious unit. They use knowledge of number relationships and a variety of representations and models to compare and order decimals and to add decimals. Our goals for this unit are to read, write, and interpret decimal fractions to thousandths; order decimals to thousandths and add decimal fractions through reasoning about place value, equivalents, and representations.

<u>Science</u> -students are working on their science fair project.
