



- *Low income.
- *Military family,
- *Parent with Disabilities or Chronic Health Condition,
- *Parent with mental illness,
- *Recent Immigrant or Refugee Family,
- *Single parent household,
- *Speakers of Other Languages/English Languages Learners,
- *Substance abuse.
- *Teen parent,
- *Very low birth weight
