Where you go next is up to you. This booklet will provide an overview of the website, with helpful tips, so you can easily access the information and extras you need!









# Find a Doctor

Need to find a doctor, hospital or other health care facility that participates in your health plan? The Find a Doctor tool makes it quick and easy to find a health care provider that meets your needs.


Visit HealthLink.com and click Find a Doctor. Select either People, Places, Tests/Imaging or All Providers to begin your search. Next, select the Type of health care provider you are looking for, such as Primary Care, Hospital or Lab Tests.

Select your **Health Plan** or **Company Name** from the drop down menu, then select the **Network** listed on your ID Card. Finally, pick the location you want to search in by entering a **Zip Code and Mile Radius** 



#### **Select Provider Category and Type**

Choose **People** for primary care providers or specialists. Select **Places** for urgent care centers, hospitals, specialty centers or labs and imaging. Choose **Tests/Imaging** for lab tests, imaging or screenings. Or you can search for all providers.



#### **Optional Search Criteria**

You can also enter additional information to narrow down your search. These fields are optional and there is no need to enter information in every field available.

# **Reading Your Search Results**

Once you have entered your search criteria, you are ready to view your results. Each result listed will include the name, address, state, zip code, phone number, network affiliation, gender, and the languages spoken by the health care provider who meets your search criteria. Click **Download Results** to automatically generate a PDF that includes information from your search results. The PDF may be printed or saved to your computer.

Need to start over? Click New Search to go back.

#### Display Results –

All of the providers who meet your search criteria will be listed in alphabetical order. There are 30 results listed per page.



## Result Display Pages –

Move through the search results easily by clicking the page you want to view.

#### Map It –

Access a map with directions to the location you searched.

### **Customized Directory PDF**

The cover identifies the network searched, the search specifications and the date. Each result includes the name, address, state, zip code, phone number and gender of the health care provider.

Grievance and Appeal Form HealthLink members have the right to document a grievance or request an appeal by filling out a simple form.



Restriction and Authorization Forms Submit the appropriate form to give authorization or request a restriction on your PHI.



Medical and Clinical Policies We provide you with easy access to electronic versions of the latest medical policies and clinical UM guidelines.



Non-Participating Provider Reimbursement
If you visit a provider outside the HealthLink network, you may be required to pay more.



Member Rights and Responsibilities Health care guidelines for consumers when receiving medical care.



Nominate a Doctor to Join Our Network Nominate a doctor, hospital or other health care facility to be added to the HealthLink network.
