Nominate Now Hall of Leaders Candidate

The Foundation is asking the community's assistance to identify individuals with outstanding achievement in the areas of service and dedication to education, youth and community. Nominations are being accepted until Friday, November 11.

The Foundation is accepting nominations in the following categories:

- **Distinguished Alumni** — (Lifetime Achievement) -- person who graduated from Camdenton School District and has become successful in his/her chosen field.
- **Outstanding Education Professionals** — teacher and/or administrator who have served the Camdenton School District for at least ten years, have been retired for at least three years and were outstanding educational leaders in the District.
- **Friends of the District** — person whose efforts have made a significant contribution to the Camdenton School District; must demonstrate leadership, character and uncommon dedication to the District; this category is not limited to alumni.

Twenty-four individuals have been inducted into the Education Foundation's Hall of Fame. Recipients' portraits are mounted and contributions engraved on the distinctive Hall of Leaders plaque prominently displayed at Camdenton High School for students, staff and visitors to view.
