The scholarship program is designed expressly for worthy Camdenton R-III certified teachers wishing to achieve advanced degrees in education. By initiating this program, the Foundation is continuing its quest and staying true to its motto "Steering the Course for the Future".

A total of 15 Educator Scholarships have been awarded in the past four years.
